#### **Bookings**

- All bookings for Wraparound Club need to be booked online in advance for a half a term block using the Onside Coaching online booking page assessable via the school website. There will be limited spaces available for Ad hoc bookings. Adhoc booking prices, due to the additional administration of Adhoc bookings are charged at £5.50 until 4.30pm, and £11.00 until 5.30pm
- Bookings cannot be made via the school office.

## **Payment**

- Payments for Wraparound sessions must be made by families via the online booking system.
- Any families who wish to use Childcare Vouchers payment for Wraparound must email wraparound@onsidecoaching.co.uk prior to booking to confirm they would like to use this method of payment. Families using Childcare Vouchers only will be invoiced for the sessions booked. All Childcare Voucher invoices must be paid by BACS to the school within 7 days of invoices being issued. Unpaid invoices after this time will result in the child being unable to attend sessions until all debts are paid.
- Payment using Childcare Vouchers is only available for Block Bookings and is not available for any Ad hoc bookings.
- We regret that we are unable to refund fees should your child not attend on the day booked.

## **Childcare Vouchers**

• The school is registered to accept Government Tax Free Childcare vouchers, Computershare vouchers, Kiddivouchers and EdenRed vouchers for After School Club payment.

#### **Late Collection**

• When children are picked up later than the session time they are booked in for, the charge for the next session on that day will automatically be added. For late collections after 5.30pm there will be a late collection charge of £15 per child for each time this occurs.

## **Behaviour**
