£1,575	2024/25 class allowances	c.105 pupils @ £15 per year – school to call off by end of Sep.
£840	2023/24 trip allowances	Allowance held for Spring/Summer term should any trips run
£20	Coffee & biscuits	Welcome first day of term – if activity is run
£20	Small society lottery license	Due 22 nd June 2024 otherwise price increases
£20	Sports day ice lollies	
£950	Bonfire night (2024)	Purchase of fireworks in August to earn discount - if event is run
£2,395	School canopy	c.£2k raised via Easter raffle with FOBS committee agreeing to fund up to this initial quote value when canopy required. Looking to optimise purchasing power with Brailes School purchasing and recovering VAT (which FOBS cannot).

This is a worse-case view (where we are unable to generate any further income before September 2024) which shows that FOBS funds are available to cover these costs with £2,357.48 surplus – which we are in discussion with Brailes School on opportunities to utilise this available funding. These events and costs are subject to change.

We also have been awarded a £400 grant from Stour Valley Lions for school playground enhancements.
